Pursuant to Regulation 30 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulation, 2015, as amended, ("**SEBI LODR Regulations**"), we wish to inform you that the United States Department of Commerce, International Trade Administration ("**US DoC**"), in the course of its administrative review of the countervailing duty ("**CVD**") order on organic soybean meal from India for the period from January 1, 2023 to December 31, 2023 ("**Administrative Review**"), has applied the 'adverse facts available' ("**AFA**") methodology to Ecopure Specialities Limited ("**Ecopure**"), a step-down subsidiary of the Company. As a result, the highest possible CVD rate of 340.27% has been imposed on Ecopure's exports of organic soybean meal to the United States..

Ecopure is presently evaluating all available legal remedies in response to the aforementioned imposition, in accordance with applicable law. As of the date of this communication, the impact of the Administrative Review on the Company has not yet been determined. The Company will continue to keep you informed of any further developments in this matter.

The relevant details, as per the requirement of Regulation 30 of the SEBI LODR Regulations, read with SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CFD-PoD-1/P/CIR/2023/123 dated July 13, 2023 and SEBI Circular SEBI/HO/CFD/CFD-PoD-2/CIR/P/2024/185 dated December 31, 2024, are given in the enclosed '**Annexure - A**'.
